Parts of Speech

What is POS?

Each word in a sentence has its own importance & purpose.

In English, there are 8 different types of words.(POS)

Noun

Pronoun

Adjective

Verb

Adverb

Conjunction

Preposition

Interjection

The 8 types are called “Parts of Speech”

Noun

In simple words: Nouns are words that name:

Things: table, chair, mobile etc.

People: Mohan, Sunita, Raj etc.

Animals: dog, cat, elephant etc.

Places: India, Navi Mumbai,
London, etc.

Some sentence examples are:

Meenakshi is driving a car.

The dog is in the park.

Navi Mumbai is a big city.

Raju bought an auto rickshaw.

Riya loves to drive the car.

Pronoun

Next Pronoun, it takes the place of nouns or it replaces nouns.

Sometimes, we do not want to use a noun. So we use a pronoun.

Pronouns are:
I
He
She
It
We
You
They

Some sentence examples are:

He doesn't like me.

She likes to eat chocolates.

You don't go there.

She is in the drawing room.

He is watching TV.

They want to play with me.

It is its key.

We walk to school every
day.

Adjectives

It describes a noun or a pronoun.

For e.g.

She is a **pretty** woman.

The man owns **3** cars.

They are **happy** people.

Mumbai is the **biggest** city.

My laptop is the **best** laptop.

Verb

Verb shows an action or state of mind.

For e.g.:

The boy **spoke** with her.

I **see** many cars on the street every day.

They **went** to Switzerland.

Mohan is **talking** to her.

They are **writing** it down.

I **told** them to pack their bags.

Adverb

Adverb describes a verb, an adjective or another adverb. In simple words, it gives additional information about the verb.

For e.g.

They will go **outside.**

She did that **correctly.**

The boy behaved **badly.**

I write **fast.**

She dances **well.**

He writes **neatly.**

Conjunction:

Conjunction joins words, phrases or small sentences.

For e.g.

Mohan **and** Meena play in the garden every day.

I opened an umbrella **because** it was raining.

You should come here **or** go home with your sister.

I like to eat pizza **but** now I don't want.

She speaks English **and** French fluently.

Preposition

It shows the relationship of a noun or pronoun to another word in a sentence.

For. e.g.

Computer is on the table.

Water is in bottle.

This cake is made of wheat flour.

This gift is for her.

I am at station.

Interjection:

Interjections words are used by people to express their strong emotions/ feelings.

For. e.g.

Hurrah! You won the gold medal.

Great job! She completes her work on time.

Oh! That's nice.

Shhh! Don't make noise.

Wow! What a beautiful dress?

Ouch! I hurt myself.
