exactly right"



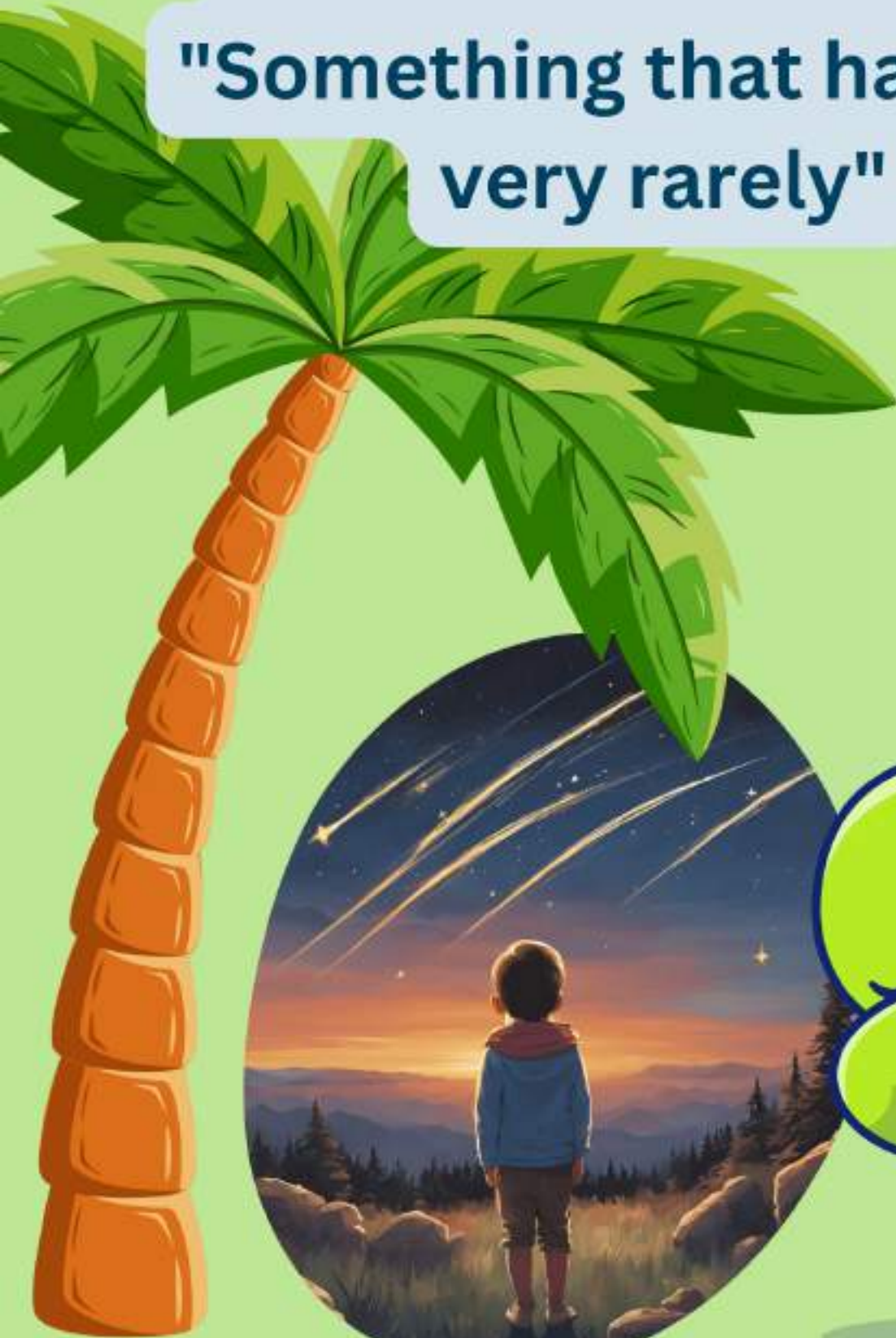
